December 14, 2018 is the six-year mark of the Sandy Hook tragedy when a gunman suffering from mental illness used an AR-15 with high capacity magazines to brutally murder 20 children and six educators.

Since that horrific day, over 600,000 Americans have been killed or injured by guns in towns and cities across our nation; there have been more than 1,800 mass shooting incidents according to Gun Violence Archive; the number of gun deaths has increased to 38,000 in 2016; and three of the five deadliest mass shootings in modern U.S. history have occurred within the last two years.

Gun violence is a public health emergency and Congress has been complicit. Congress has offered up thoughts and prayers but it has failed to take action to end gun violence in America. Congress must find the courage to reject the corporate gun lobby to protect all Americans from gun violence.

It's time for Congress to #HonorWithAction. Therefore, a coalition of 80 gun violence prevention organizations and allies representing seven million Americans, implore you to pass these sensible gun laws that will help to steadily reduce gun homicides, gun suicides, unintentional shootings, mass shootings and gun injuries in America.

- 1. Background checks on all gun sales
- 2. Close the Charleston loophole or "delayed denial" where federally licensed dealers can sell guns if three business days pass without a verdict from the FBI
- 3. Restrict and penalize firearm possession by or transfer to a person subject to a domestic violence protection order or a person (including dating partners) convicted of a domestic violence misdemeanor
- 4. Prohibit firearm sale or transfer to and receipt or possession by an individual who has: (1) been convicted in any court of a misdemeanor hate crime, or (2) received from any court an enhanced hate crime misdemeanor sentence
- 5. Mandatory waiting period for gun purchases
- 6. Red flag/gun violence restraining order/extreme risk protection order to temporarily prohibit an individual deemed by a judge to pose a danger to self or others, from purchasing or possessing firearms or ammunition and allow law enforcement to remove any firearms or ammunition already in the individual's possession
- 7. Handgun permitting, licensing, training, and registration
- 8. Ban bump-fire stocks and other dangerous accessories
- 9. Ban future manufacture and sale of assault weapons, regulate existing assault weapons under the National Firearms Act of 1934, and initiate a federal gun buyback program
- 10. Limits on high capacity magazines
- 11. Prohibit open carry
- 12. Make gun trafficking a federal crime
- 13. Repeal Protection of Lawful Commerce in Arms Act (PLCAA) to eliminate the corporate gun industry special protection from civil justice law that no other industry enjoys
- 14. Fund government research on gun violence
- 15. Child access prevention/safe storage requirement
- 16. Provide resources for people with mental illness
- 17. Microstamped code on each bullet that links it to a specific gun
- 18. "Smart guns" with Radio Frequency Identification (RFID) or biometric recognition (finger-print) capability
- 19. Limit gun purchases to one gun per month to reduce trafficking and straw purchases
- 20. Require licensing for ammunition dealers
- 21. Enhance accountability of federally licensed firearms dealers
- 22. Digitize the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF) gun records
- 23. Raise the minimum age for gun purchases to 21
- 24. Ban 3D and ghost guns
- 25. Prohibit guns in schools and college campuses
- 26. Report lost and stolen guns

Congress can do more to end gun violence in America to make our communities safer therefore we demand a vote on these common sense measures. If Congress fails to take action again then another 400,000 Americans will be killed or injured by guns and we will witness more and more horrific mass shooting incidents before the 10-year mark of the Sandy Hook tragedy.
